These schools provide an opportunity for a brighter future to more than 4,600 girls in the sixth through twelfth grades, with approximately 68% of the students coming from economically disadvantaged backgrounds and approximately 68% of the students being first generation college students. Each school offers advanced placement courses, teaches a science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) curriculum, and is built upon core values of college readiness, responsible leadership, and wellness life skills. The goal of YWPN is to continue to graduate 100% of its enrolled students and to continue with its 100% acceptance rates at colleges and universities across the country.

Why Girls Education?

Studies have shown that investing in girls' education reaps a double-dividend – a college-educated young woman is more likely to become an adult that invests in her children's education and that tips the balance from poverty to progress not only for herself, but for her future family. We at TXWSW are volunteering our time, resources and passion for the future of girls' education and, in turn, the future of our State. We ask you to help us continue to work to change outcomes and break the cycle of poverty for underserved girls in our community and their future families.
